7 days Wildlife Safari- Nairobi * Maasai Mara National Reserve * Lake Nakuru National Park * Amboseli National Park

Day 1 - Nairobi

Upon arrival at the Jomo Kenyatta international airport, you will be met and transferred to Nairobi Serena hotel for dinner and overnight. **BED & BREAKFAST**

Day 2 - Maasai Mara National Reserve

Wake up early and depart at 0700hrs after breakfast to the Maasai Mara. Travel towards Kenya's fertile highlands and head down the Rift Escarpment on a road built by Italian prisoners of war during World War II. Look for the charming chapel they built at the foot of the escarpment. You'll pass the impressive Longonot earth satellite station as you head across the Valley to Narok, and then travel across acres of wheat and barley,



before you reach the Maasai Mara in time for lunch at Mara Serena Lodge. Following lunch enjoy an afternoon game drive to view most of the Maasai Mara. Masai Mara has a rolling savannah landscape dotted with shrubs and bush thickets and is the Kenyan part of the large ecosystem stretching south to Serengeti in Tanzania. The wildlife in Masai Mara is varied, ranging

from the big cats to elephant, rhino and vast herds of herbivores such as wildebeest. Mara is the best place for spotting all the big five animals i.e. lion, rhino, elephant, buffalo and leopard. After the game drive, drive back to the lodge.

Day 3 - Maasai Mara National Reserve

Early morning and afternoon game drives in the park. All meals will be served in Serena. Alternatively you can have a (optional) early morning balloon safari in the morning at an extra cost.

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Day 4 – Lake Nakuru National Park

Leaving the Masai Mara after breakfast, you will now travel across the vast plains on the floor of the Rift Valley, keeping an eye out for herds of giraffe and gazelle as you head up the Mai - Mahiu, before arriving in Lake Nakuru Sarova lion hill lodge in time for lunch. The waters here are often colored shimmering flamingo pink, from thousands of the beautiful birds lining its shores. The park is home not just to lesser and greater flamingos but over 400 species of birds and its one of the few places to see the endangered white rhino. Other wildlife in the park includes lions, leopards, Zebras, Gazelles, elands, giraffes and hyrax. You will take an afternoon game drive in Nakuru National Park before returning to Sarova lion hill Lodge for dinner and overnight. The lodge is strategically located on a hill side to afford a panoramic view of the flamingo pink rimmed lake

Accommodation: Sarova lion hill lodge (Full board)

Day 5 – Amboseli National Park

After an early breakfast, you will leave rift valley behind and head back to Nairobi. Collect picnic lunch from Nairobi and then head towards Amboseli National park. Arrive in Amboseli in the late afternoon. You will have a game drive en route to your lodge. The park is famous for being the best place in Africa to get close to free-ranging elephants among other wildlife species. The



park offers Stunning views of Mount Kilimanjaro, Africa's highest peak and the highest free-standing mountain in the world. Even though the majestic Kilimanjaro is located in Tanzania, the best views of it are, in fact, from Amboseli National Park which is strategically located at the foot of the mountain.

Accommodation: Amboseli Serena (Full board)

Day 6 - Amboseli National Park

Early morning and afternoon game drives in the park. All meals will be served in Serena.

Accommodation: Amboseli Serena (Full board)

Day 7 - Homebound

After breakfast you will enjoy your last game drive in the park as you head back to Nairobi to arrive in time for lunch. Upon arrival in Nairobi, you will be transferred to Carnivore restaurant. The Carnivore is considered 'Africa's Greatest Eating Experience'. This open-air meat specialty restaurant has strikingly different food, service and atmosphere to anything ever seen in Kenya.



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Every type of meat imaginable, including four choices of wild game, are roasted on traditional Masai swords over a huge, visually spectacular charcoal pit that dominates the entrance of the restaurant. The waiters then carry these swords around the restaurant, carving unlimited amounts of the prime meats onto sizzling, cast iron plates in front of you. A wide selection of salads, vegetable side dishes, and a variety of exotic sauces accompany the meat feast. Dessert and coffee follow this. After lunch you will be transferred to the airport for your international flight home.
